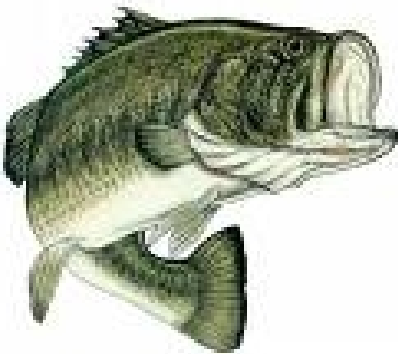

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: USE AT A RATE OF 4# PER SURFACE ACRE OF WATER

1.	Make the first application of fertilizer in early Spring when water temperature reaches 65 degrees. Follow with two additional applications at two-week intervals.
2.	Make three more applications at three-week intervals.
3.	Continue applications at monthly intervals or whenever the water clears enough that a white disk attached to a yardstick is visible to a depth of 18 inches.
4.	Stop applications by the last week in October.

Use Secchi Disk to monitor algae bloom; a reading between 18-24 inches is sufficient. When water clarity allows readings greater than 24 inches, apply more fertilizer.

FISH POND FERTILIZATION CAN INCREASE FISH YIELDS BY 2 TO 4 TIMES. IN ADDITION TO INCREASED YIELDS, THE FISH WILL BE IN BETTER CONDITION. WELL- FERTILIZED PONDS CAN MAINTAIN THREE TO FOUR HUNDRED POUNDS OF FISH PER ACRE. CONSULT YOUR LOCAL COUNTY AGENT OR UNIVERSITY FOR MORE INFORMATION ABOUT FISH POND MAINTENANCE.

PREVENTION
